





- Two airports transferred: YYC- 1992 & YBW- 1997
- Authority is a non-share capital corporation
 - ✓ To manage and operate the airports for which we are responsible in a safe, secure and efficient manner
 - ✓ To advance economic and community development by means that include promoting and encouraging improved airline and transportation service and an expanded aviation industry
- All \$\$ reinvested back into airport facility restoration and improvements (YYC/YBW)
 - The Authority has invested over \$1.15B into YYC and paid over \$330M in airport rent since 1992
- Airport Rent largest single expense





Economic Impact of YYC...

- Hub for world class carriers
 – WestJet head quarters, Air Canada, KLM, Lufthansa, British Airways
- 162,000 aircraft movements per year
- 111,000 tonnes cargo
- \$6B value added GDP

Passenger Activity (2011)


Total Passengers – 12.7 Million

35,000 Passengers/day














- •Runway identified and land reserved back in 1970's.
- •Federally Registered Airport Zoning in place since 1977.
- •AVPA Provincial Airport Vicinity Protection Area Regulation in place since 1979 – regulation of land use and heights.
- •YYC Master Plans have shown same alignment and thresholds for 14000ft runway.


